


Pre-launch announcement

New additions to the 'Little People's Literacy Learning' modules for parents and carers

On International Literacy Day, 8 September 2018, ALEA will launch an additional nine modules as part of the *Little People's Literacy Learning* guide for parents and carers. The new modules complement the 18 modules that were released in 2018.

The new modules provide:

- guides for working parents, at-home parents of babies and toddlers, and at-home parents with 2 and 3 year-olds;
- guides to developing the language of mental maths, number, measurement, space and shape, and pattern;
- a guide to technology use.

Written by Anita Ayer, a retired early years teacher, and Professor Trevor Cairney OAM, the modules are open access and free of charge.
