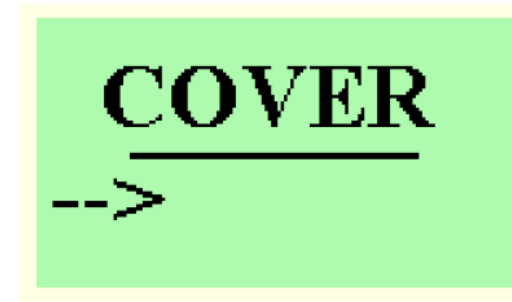
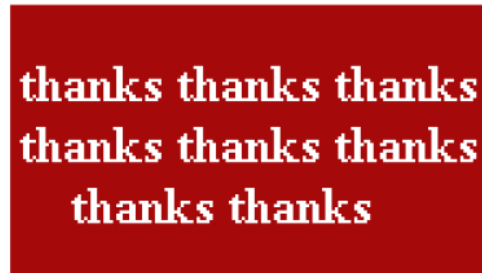

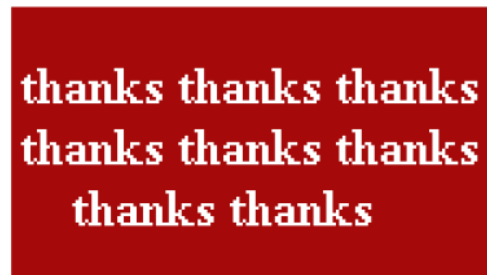

AGE OF COMPULSION

The requirements have changed slightly in the past 2 years.

- Compulsory school age is 6-16 years
- Compulsory education age is 6-17 years
- They must be in an approved learning program until the turn 17 unless:
 - They achieve their SACE
 - They are in full-time employment

Leaving school early for full time employment

15 Years old – seek an exemption but they need a job with minimum 30 hours

16 Years old – need a job with minimum 25 hours

ATTENDANCE

Our school goal is for every student to be above 95%

We need all students to attend all lessons, including morning caregroup (Daymap is vital)

Importance of attendance

- Our two students that achieved above 90 ATAR had attendance rates above 90%. There was a strong correlation between attendance and ATAR performance.
- Currently the secondary is sitting at 83%

PART TIME WORK

Students are allowed to have part time work considering:

- They are not assigned to work during school hours**
- It should not interfere with their schooling (late night shifts that make them tired for school)

**employers and parents can be prosecuted for this

WORK EXPERIENCE

- Is not a pre-requisite for government schools anymore
 - However after discussions with parents and students we believe it is a valuable experience for our learners.
 - We have outlined week 10 of term 1 – need to have confirmation of work place by week 7
 - Please note that it has become increasingly difficult for students to secure placements

CAREERSTRIP

- Valuable learning experience
- Ms Novillos along with the learners are currently planning their trip to coincide with their career pathways

PICHI RICHI

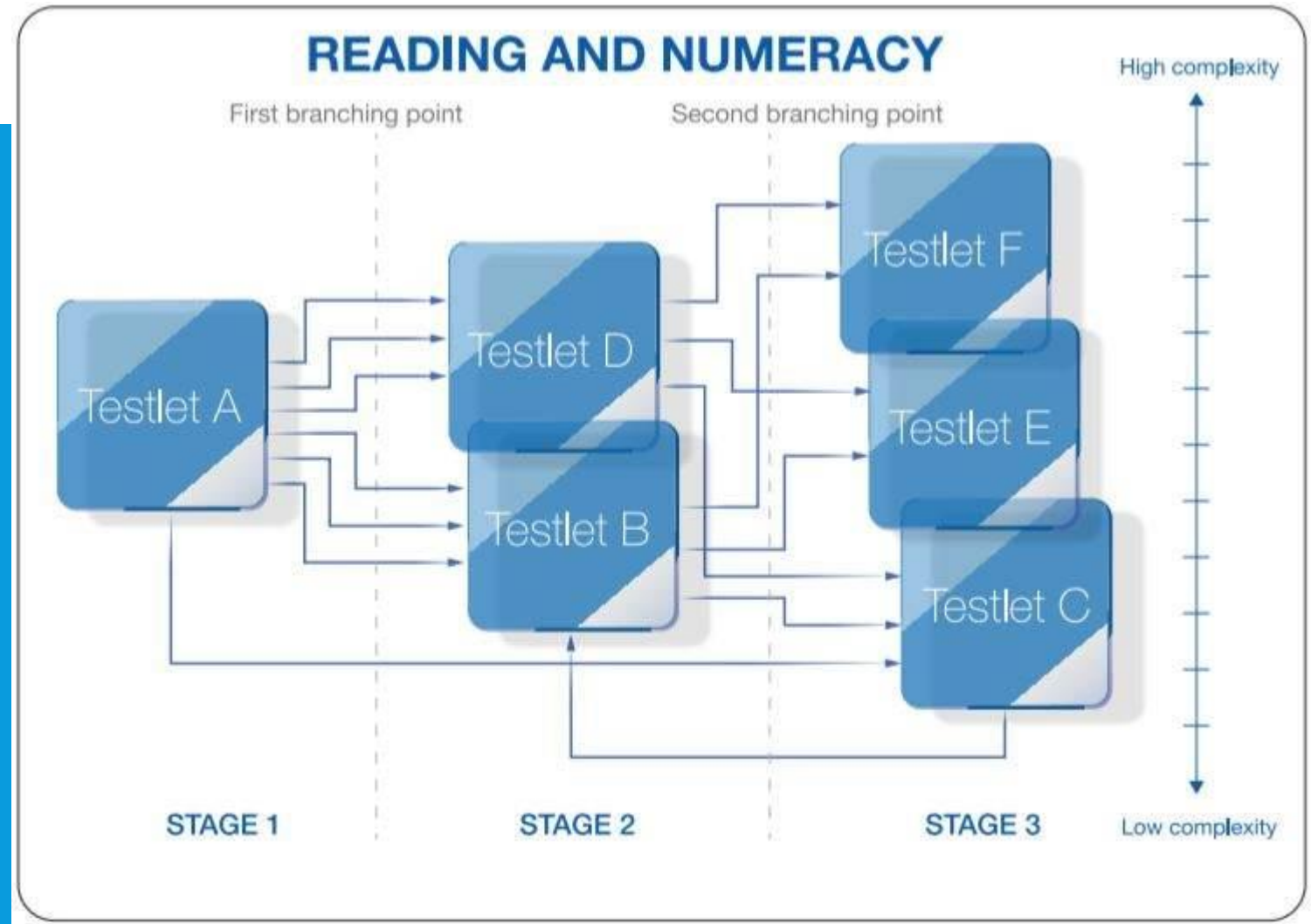
Our results in 2019 were great

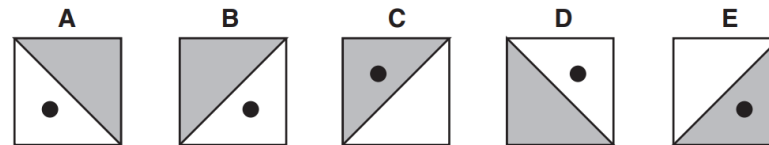
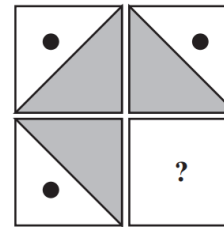

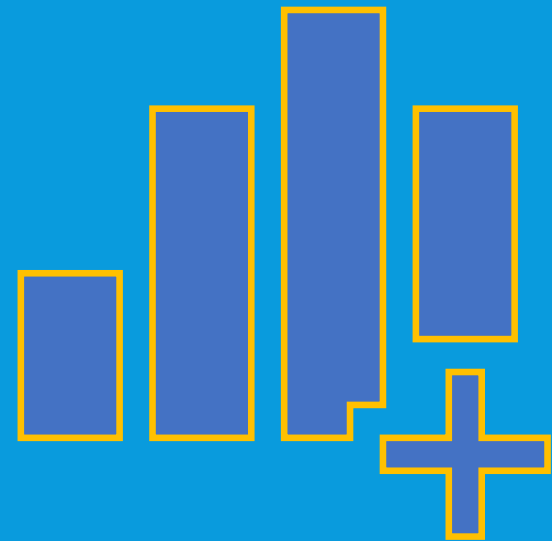
